Day 1-9th March

Depart Sydney and arrive Johannesburg in the afternoon. Transfer to Indaba hotel .B&B. (if desired Liz will hold a group to allow any interested parties to connect with any African past life experiences and the purpose thereof.)

Day 2-10th March

(Soweto choir visit will either be on this day or the day 5.)

Breakfast and you are collected by coach and taken to the town of Kuruman, a four hour drive. Tour guide Gerhardt will tell us about the history of the area, site of the first mission station and church of David Livingstone. We will be taken to home of Credo Mutwa for introductions/offerings and then to the B&B for overnight.

Day 3-11th March. Drive to Credo Mutwas' house for a day with him and his wife Virginia .A tour of the facilities will be offered.

Credo expects us to ask questions and select the topics of conversation. He is old and a bit fragile so we have to play it by ear as to how long we can stay on each visit.

Credo is keeper of the Zulu artefacts and may show us some of them if appropriate. Return to Kuruman accommodation. B&B.





Day 4-12th March. Credo and/ or Virginia will take us to the bushman caves. Credo and Virginia have both been initiated into the Bushman tradition and Credo has a lot to share out the paintings and what they mean. Kuruman B&B.



Day 5-13th March .Return to Johannesburg, to the Indaba Hotel for rest. B&B.

Day 6-14th March. Transfer to the airport for the flight to Victoria Falls...

Arrive at Victoria Falls and you are escorted to your hotel. A'Zambezi Hotel. B&B.



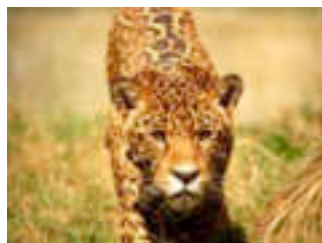

Day 8-16th March. Return flight to Johannesburg. Indaba .B&B.

Day 9-17thMarch. Transfer after breakfast to the airport for your flight to Kenya, flying very close to Mt Kilimanjaro en-route. On arrival we are collected and transferred to the Stanley hotel .In the centre of Nairobi. B&B.





Day 10-18th March. Morning drive via Narok, a Masai town, and on to the Masai Mara National Reserve offering wonderful scenery and plentiful game. God's garden.

Lunch at Mara Simba Lodge. Afternoon game drive with a visit to Masai Village.

Day 11-19th March. Morning game drive and then return drive to Nairobi.

Day 12-20th March .Day in Nairobi with the healers. (I am also trying to arrange a viewing of a film made by friends in Nairobi about the healers.)

There will be more information about the healers coming soon.

Day 13-21st March. Another day with the healers. (If there is any spare time at the end of the sessions Liz can direct you to places and things to see.)

Day 14-22nd March. After breakfast we set off again out into a very different part of the country. Passing through Kikuyu agricultural lands and out to the slopes of Mount Kenya we drive on through the drier lands seeing different tribes people such as the Somali, Samburu and Boran. Arriving in the Samburu National Park in the semi- desert one sees animals only found north of the equator, as well as the savannah animals and the big five.

Now you can see the African animals in some wonderful remote and wild places .A game drive en route into the park and arrive at Samburu Serena Lodge.(If desired Liz will hold a group to allow you to connect with the soul of the animals)

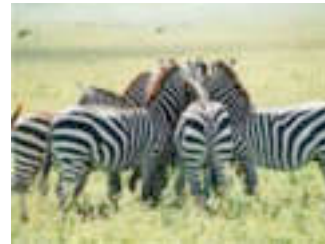


After lunch and a swim we will go to the Samburu Village. Samburu are cousins to the Masai people .We can ask to talk with their Laibon. The Laibon is the spiritual leader and healer for the village/clan.

At the village you are allowed to take photos and you can also buy some Samburu artefacts and beaded and carved objects. You might like to bring stuff to give away too like pens, paper, lighters, T-shirts etc. After returning to the lodge we can take another long game drive

before sunset. Even at the lodge you can see plenty of surprising wildlife around you!! Samburu Serena FB.

Day 15-23rd March. Your early morning game drive will take you on an extensive route through the park and along the banks of the Ewaso Ngiro River. We continue on back to Nairobi.

Day 16-24th March. Day at Leisure in Nairobi. Liz will take you to the Markets and direct you to restaurants, galleries, the Giraffe centre, Karen Blixen Museum and other attractions.

Credo Mutwa

Credo.V.Mutwa was born in the Natal area of South Africa on July 22 1921.His very name is a composite of his cultures origin.

“Vusamazulu” is a Zulu honorific meaning,” awakener of the Zulus”, given to him during his initiation as a Sangoma.The name “Credo” from the Latin,” I believe” and Mutwa is Zulu for “little bushman”. True to his middle name Vusamazulu, he is a spiritual leader dedicated to caring for his people and [preserving their cultural traditions.

As an authority on the history, lore, legends and fables of tribes throughout the sub-continent, Credo excels in the medium of story telling. He believes that the tales that he learned from his elders gave directions for his life and motivated him to further his knowledge of his people’s past, and share that learning. He earned international recognition with his first published work in the 1960’s “Indaba My Children”, re-printed internationally and translated into several

languages followed by “Africa Is My Witness” and “Let Not My Children Die”. The multi-talented man is also an artist, a sculpture and healer.

1996 he published “Song of the Stars” and “Isilwane The Animal” As a true pioneer, Credo has travelled internationally and become an acknowledged cultural historian on traditional healing. He has attended and spoken at conferences and is a guest of philosophers, therapists and creative artists around the world.

There is a Zulu saying that travelling creates an Induna. This means that one who is to become a leader must first gain wide experience before assuming his duties.

Credo is a perfect example of a wise global leader. His home is open to those who come with respect and love and he willingly shares his amazing and wide-ranging knowledge.
